Bylaw Change Proposal

Current Bylaw 44

OFFICERS OF THE SOCIETY

44. The Executive Officers of the Society shall be:

- (a) President (elected by AAWA voting members) (2 year term-2 consecutive term limit)
- (b) Past-President (ex officio) (2 year term- No consecutive term limit)
- (c) Vice-President (elected by AAWA voting members) (2 year term -No consecutive term limit)
- (d) Secretary-Treasurer (elected by AAWA voting members) (2 year term - No consecutive term limit)
- (e) 2 Executive Officers at Large as required by the Board (elected by AAWA voting members) (2 year term No consecutive term limit)
- (f) Coaches' Representative: (elected by AAWA voting members) (2 year term -No consecutive term limit)
- (g) Officials' Representative: (on the direction of the AAWOA)
- (h) Female Athletes' Representative (elected by female Senior (18 year of age or older) Athlete members)
- (i) Male Athletes' Representative (elected by male Senior (18 year of age or older) Athlete members)

There must be at least one Executive Officer from each of the following regions of Alberta:

- 1) Calgary (Zone 3)
- 2) Edmonton (Zone 6)
- 3) North (Zones 5, 7, 8)
- 4) South (Zones 1, 2, 4)

Proposed Bylaw Change 44

OFFICERS OF THE SOCIETY

44. The Executive Officers of the Society shall be:

- (a) President*
- (b) Past-President*
- (c) Vice-President*
- (d) Secretary-Treasurer*
- (e) 2 Executive Officers at Large as required by the Board*



(f) Coaches' Representative:

(g) Officials' Representative:

(h) Female Athletes' Representative

(i) Male Athletes' Representative

President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, Coaches' Representative, Officials Representative and Executive Officers are elected by the AAWA voting members and will serve two (2) year terms.

Female Athletes' Representative and Male Athletes' Representative will serve a two (2) year term and are voted in by Athlete Members 18 years of age and older. Female athlete members will elect the Female Athletes' Representative and Male athlete members will elect the Male Athletes' Representative.

Directors may not serve more than three (3) consecutive terms in the same role.

The Past-President shall be the individual who most recently completed a term as President, and that individual shall serve as Past-President for a term coinciding with the term of their successor as President.

If the immediately preceding President is unable or unwilling to serve as Past-President, or if a President did not complete a full term, the Board may either: (i) appoint the most recent individual to have completed a full term as President to fill the role for the remainder of the term; or (ii) leave the position vacant until the next Past-President becomes eligible under this section.

There must be at least one Executive Officer from each of the following regions of Alberta:

- 1) Calgary (Zone 3)*
- 2) Edmonton (Zone 6)*
- 3) North (Zones 5, 7, 8)*
- 4) South (Zones 1, 2, 4)*

Current Bylaw 46

46. Starting in 2024 and in even years thereafter, the President, Coaches' Representative and one Executive Officer at Large shall be elected or appointed.

Proposed Bylaw 46

46. In even years, the President, Coaches' Representative, Male Athlete Representative and one Executive Officer at Large shall be elected or appointed.



Current Bylaw 47

47. Starting in 2025 and in odd years thereafter, the Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer and one Executive Officer at Large shall be elected or appointed.

Proposed Bylaw 47

47. In odd years thereafter, the Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, Officials' Representative, Female Athlete Representative and one Executive Officer at Large shall be elected or appointed.



Positions Up for Election

The following positions are up for election at the 2025 Annual General Meeting:

- President- 2 Year Term
- Coaches Representative- 2 Year Term
- Director at Large- 2 Year Term
