



Coach Travel Subsidy for International Events

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1. Purpose

This policy outlines the eligibility, conditions, and process for providing subsidies to coaches who are travelling to high-level international tournaments to accompany athletes representing Wrestling Canada.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Only one coach per team travelling to an international event may receive a travel subsidy.

To be eligible for a travel subsidy, coaches must:

- Be currently registered and in good standing with Alberta Amateur Wrestling Association
- Be a NCCP Competition Development trained coach
- Be supporting athletes who have been selected to compete for Team Canada
- Have a minimum of 2 athletes participating
- Not have received a travel subsidy for another event in the same year
- Not be receiving funding or payment from Wrestling Canada Lute for the same competition

3. Funding

Funding is subject to a maximum cap per coach, determined annually based on number of applications and budget availability. The maximum per coach will not exceed \$1000.00

Coaches are encouraged to request matching funding from their home club.

4. Application Process

Coaches must submit the following information to the AAWA:

- Event details
- Athletes being supported

5. Approval

Decisions will be communicated within 10 working days of submission.
